



The Rules Apply to All National Community League Matches

- Each team will be placed in a conference of 8 teams based on team average.
- A team will bowl against each team in the conference making for 7 weeks of conference bowling
- A match is 2 games
- A team is made up of 4 bowlers
- A team roster may have up to 8 bowlers – 4 substitutes and 4 match bowlers
- If a community has more than one team, a bowler may bowl on more than one team but must bowl separate games for each team
- Scoring
 - A match is worth 5 points
 - 2 points for the winning team in each game
 - 1 point for the team with the highest pin count for the 2 games
 - (tie games are worth 1 point to each team)
- Other
 - A team must select the 4 bowlers prior to bowling – do not bowl all the roster bowlers and then take the 4 best scores
 - Coaches post scores by Thursday of bowling week by end of end of day. If you must bowl on Friday, scores must be posted by end of day on Friday
 - If a coach has issues posting scores, email the scores to the Commissioner – dennis@nslgames.com
 - Scores are final end of day on Friday of bowling week
